Augustus L. "Gus" Kasopsky longtime resident of Raleigh passed away at the age of 90 April 15, 2019 at Transitions Life Care.

Gus was born in Cold Point, PA. to the late Lewis & Stella Kasopsky. He is also preceded in death by brother, John and sisters, Ann & Marie.

After serving 4 years in the Air Force during the Korean War he married and eventually moved his family to Raleigh in 1959. Gus was a gentle soul and called many customers his friend while working and finally retiring with the US Postal Service. After retirement he found enjoyment working another 13 years with the News & Observer until the age of 76. He was an active parishioner of Sacred Heart Cathedral and then St Raphael Catholic for 60 plus years serving on many committees, dedicated usher and member of the Knights of Columbus.
